What is Visual Rhythm? This is the result of pattern combined with implied movement. Elements or motifs are combined to create a series of regular pauses (stops and starts) for the viewer's eye, similar to the way a drum beat creates a series of pauses for the listener's ears.

Pattern: A principle of design in which the repetition of elements or combination of elements forms a recognizable organization.
(Wallpaper patterns, Repetitive line work, etc...)
