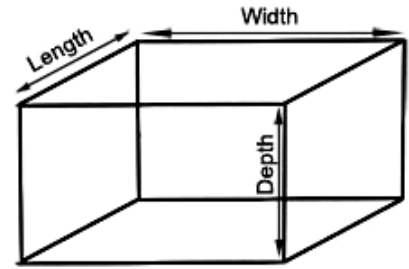

**Element of Design: Form**

**Categories of Forms:**






**Organic Form:**
