We will construct a simple portfolio that will be used to hold much of the work that you will be producing this semester. You will store your portfolio in the designated area. Your portfolio is not the only one here, therefore you need to keep it clean and organized and make sure you always put your work back into your portfolio. You are expected to go through your portfolio only, please do not go through other peoples portfolios; unless that person asks you too. If asked to move someone else's work you must be careful when handling their work to prevent damaging it.

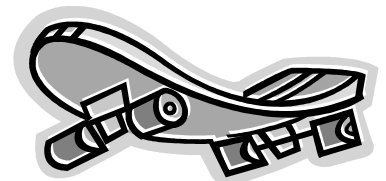


Constructing:

You will be provided with a piece of Bristol board. You will fold the tall end in half and stapling both sides.



Portfolio Design:



We will spend a few days and create a personal design on the front of your portfolio. You will be marked out of 15 for communication. The design has to have the following information:

- Your Name (It will be your title)
- The period you are in: Period _____
- Has to say "Visual Arts"
- Border
- 5 different types of lines
- 2 drawings
- 3 different colours
- Outline with marker
- Colour with pencil crayons
- Everything is neat & clean (watch for going outside your lines, finger prints, and smudging)
- Portfolio must be completely filled in, there are NO blank spaces.
