| <p>1) Silhouette Cut out:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Choose a position to pose in. b. Stand in front of the overhead, and using a white pencil on black construction paper your partner will trace your outline using the overhead. c. You will then do the same for your partner. d. Cut out your outline – any difficult areas ask the teacher or another student to help cut. |
| <p>2) Background:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Using white glue and tissue paper, you will create a background that fits the style of your pose. b. You may choose whatever colour you’d like – in construction paper c. You must have 4 different colour tissue papers for your background. |
| <p>3) Ear phones / Head phones</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Using white construction paper, you will draw out some ear phones or headphones b. Then cut them out |
| <p>4) Piecing everything together</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. When your background is finished you will use white glue and glue your black silhouette onto your background b. Then you will glue your white headphones or earphones onto your silhouette. |
